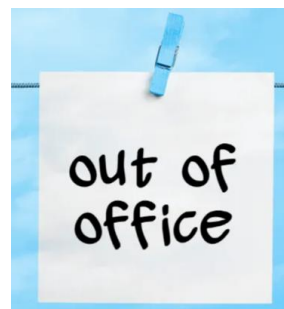

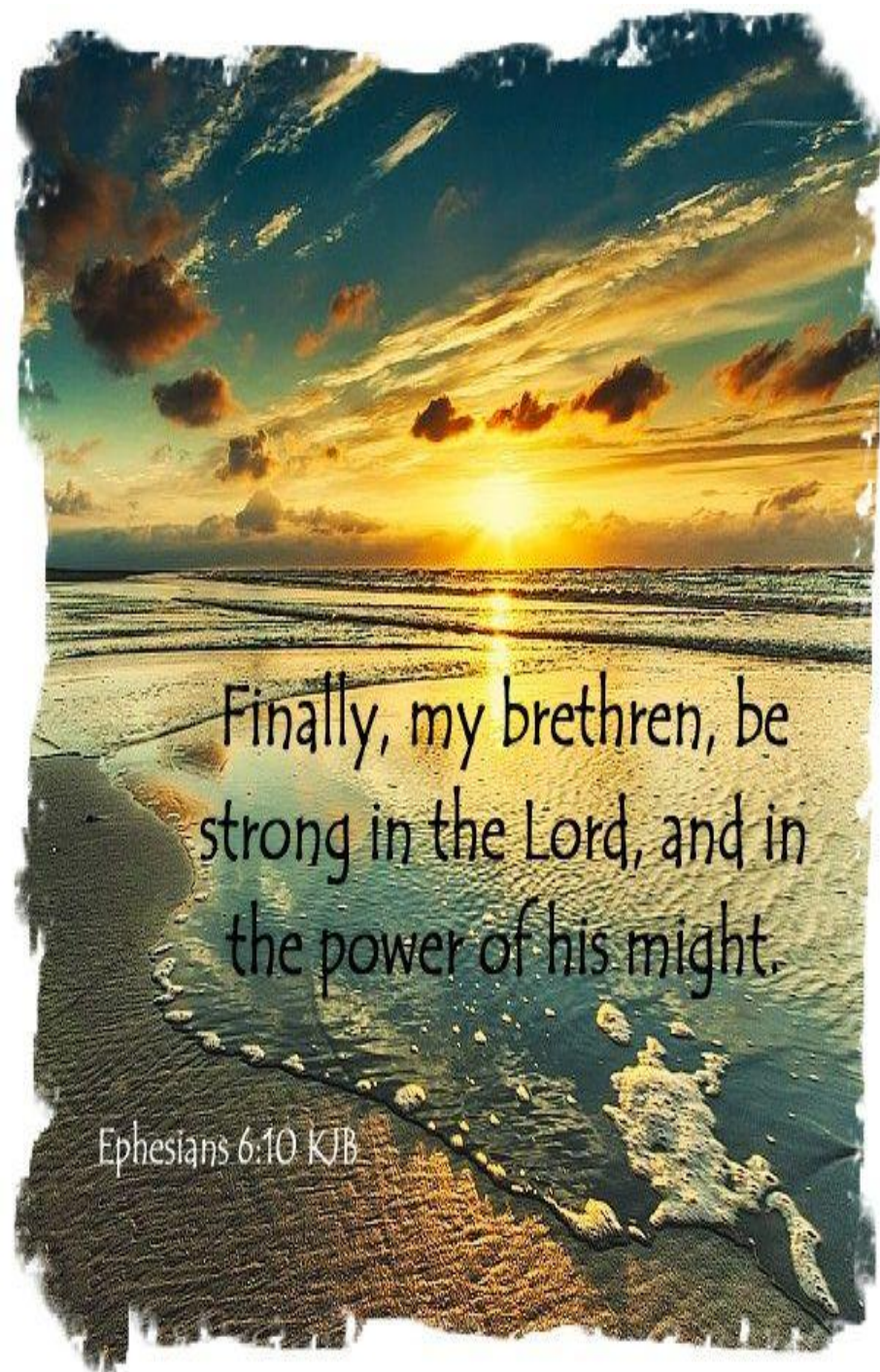

The arrangement of purple irises is in memory of Mike Miller who passed away 15 years ago on April 28th at the age of 23 and is given by Karin and Dan Miller. Mike was an active member in Sunday school, MYF, playing his tenor saxophone for many years with the Worship Team, and helping with the MCC Relief Sale and Springs Folk Festival.

Through your encouragement and support, Mike's playing flourished. He auditioned and toured twice with the California-based music ministry, The Continentals. The Continental Singers and Brass performed here at Springs in 2003 as part of their 3-month tour before going to Germany and Switzerland for 2 weeks. Then in 2009 Mike was selected for The Encore Continentals for a 3-week tour of Ireland and the UK. The Continentals, which began in 1965 and had included over 65,000 participants throughout its existence, disbanded in 2010.
