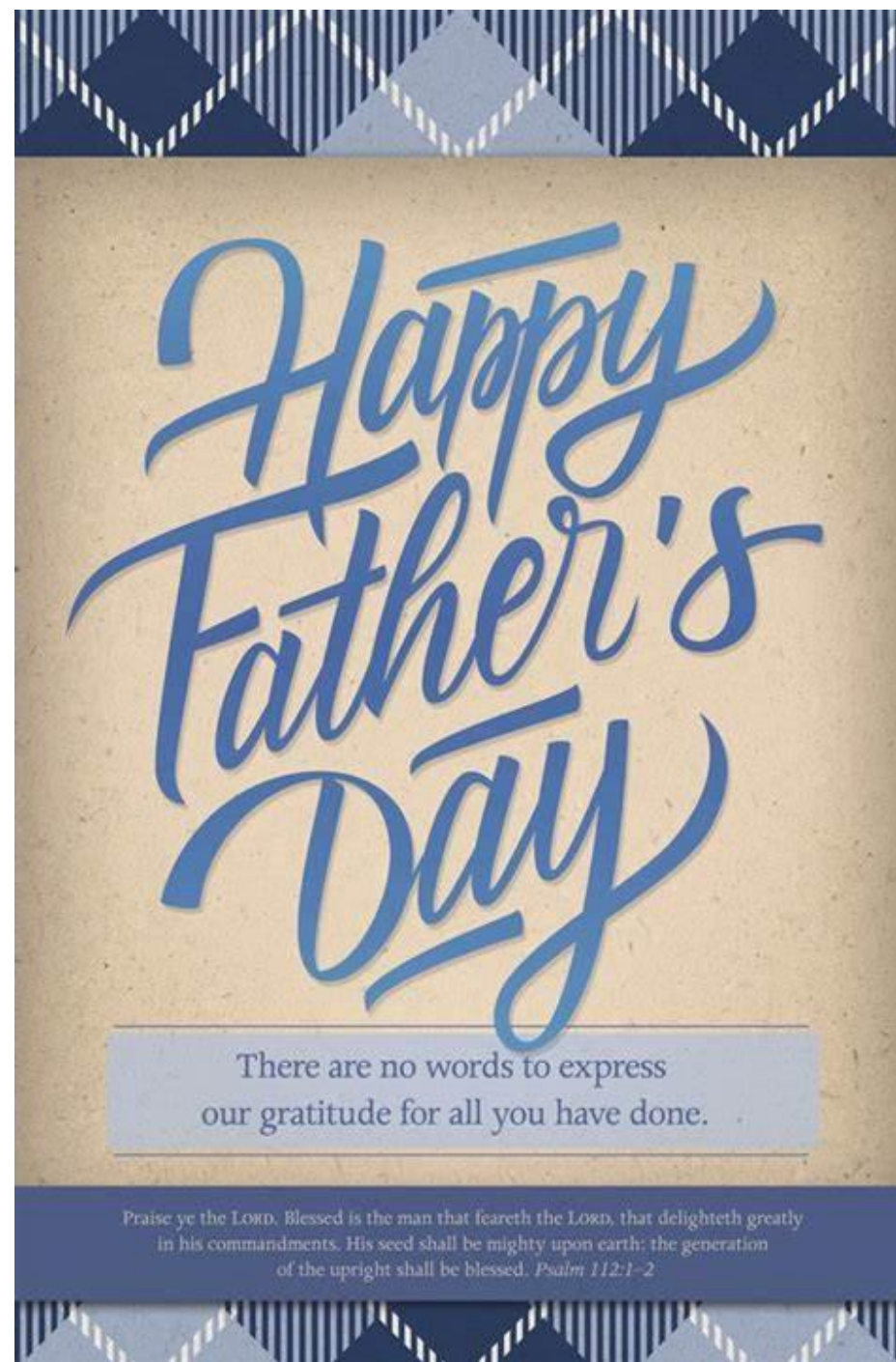

AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is located at the back of the church near the elevator.



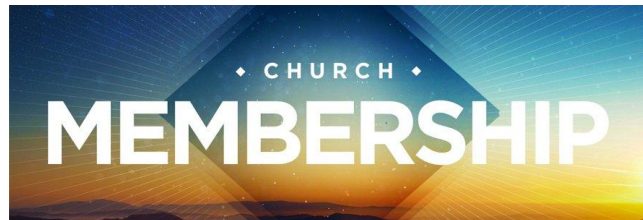
Allegheny Conference - Celebration of Congregations the weekend of August 1 – 3.

6. Council talked about some things in the attic that could be disposed of or donated to the Tri-State Relief Sale in July or to the free yard sale in August.



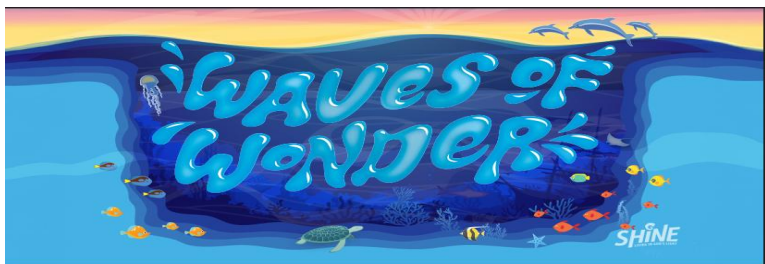
