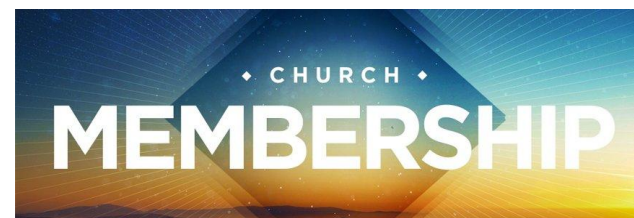

Items still needed for VBS

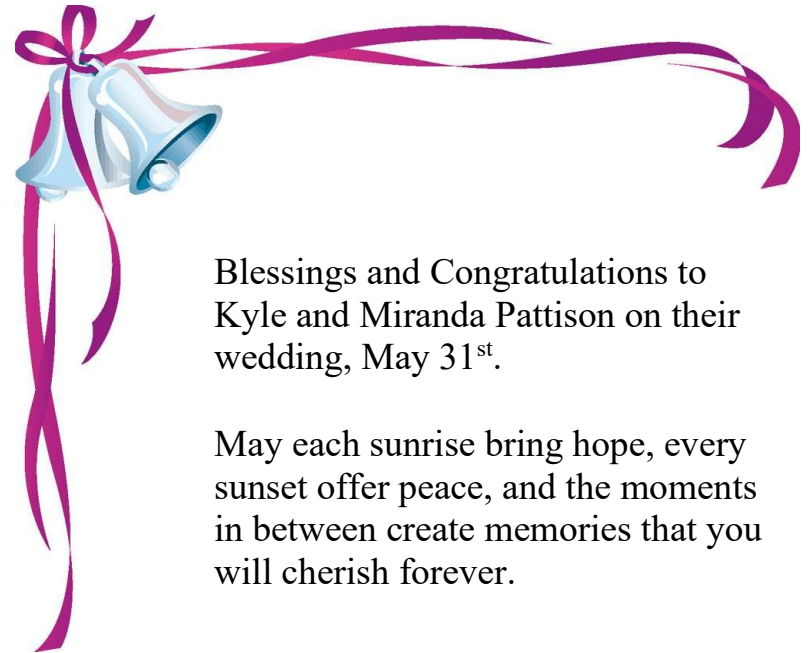
Seven jars or containers to represent each of the days of creation, filled according to this suggested list of items:
