Church Council January 5, 2016 - Significant Items

- 3. The training for AED (automated external defibrillator) will be January 21, 2016 at 6:30 p.m. Eric reported approximately 10 people have signed up.
- 4. Elders used some money out of the Alms fund to help a person buy fuel until they were able to get other assistance.
- 5. Trustees were looking at possibly getting the ceiling painted in the basement before they started on the floor. They are also looking into some rolling room dividers to take the place of the curtains that were taken down.
- 6. The Adult Sunday School classes will be moving around during the abatement process.
