

Church Council Significant Items August 14, 2018

- 1. Reminder that Sunday School classes and other organizations their financial reports need to be reviewed by two people prior to the Annual Report Booklet submission.
- 2. Budget request forms have been put into the church mailboxes for the coming year.
- 3. Brayden Thomas' Service Adventure has been fully funded.
- 4. \$15,000 will be withdrawn from the CD that becomes due 08/15 to help cover expenses for August.
- 5. MCC reported that they are not in need of school kit supplies at this time.
- 6. A thank you note was received from Mennonite Mission Network for our support of Inga Haglund's Service Adventure program during the past 10 ½ months.
- 7. Sunday school superintendents are currently in the process of contacting teachers for the coming year.
- 8. This being Luann and Robert's last Council meeting, they together gave an overview of their experiences for the past 11 months. They have felt the support of both Springs and the conference.
- 9. Sunday School classes will be asked to discuss how they feel would be the best way to funnel funds to conference or if people do not want their giving to go to conference.
- 10. Volunteers are needed to help operate the soup/sandwich booth at the Folk Festival due to lack of MYF and JYF kids.
- 11. Next scheduled meeting will be Tuesday, September 18, 2018. This will be the combined meeting of both outgoing and incoming Council members to prepare next year's budget.
