PRAYER PRAISE

A praise! Last week's trip to the Hazelton women's prison was disheartening. The chaplain forgot he had told me one week earlier that my classes could begin as scheduled, nor had he publicized my classes, so none of the women even knew I was coming! Today the chaplain showed me the combined-course flyer he had posted for the women this past week, he had orderlies set up the chapel with tables and chairs, and the 8-10 women who came to the shortened combined class last week after the chaplain asked me to make an announcement following the memorial service had spread the word. I now have 35 women in "Becoming a Woman of Excellence" and 29 in "Learning to Forgive and Other Life Lessons," including a woman who told me at the end of the second class today that she had come only to speak to the chaplain, but something drew her in to register for both courses. I told her it was prayer; the elders prayed that those who should be in the classes would find them. I have a number of Spanish speaking women with poor English skills, and the chaplain plans to meet with them each Friday to further discuss "Becoming a Woman of Excellence." Thank you all for your prayers! Please continue praying for the women (and the chaplain!) and me. Phoebe
