

November 2, 2021

1. The October 17 Allegheny Conference offering exceeded the maximum of \$5,000.00, and the amount over \$5,000.00 was placed in the general fund.
2. November 14 will be the annual above-budget Missions Offering.
3. Plans were made to have the changes to the By-Laws that were approved at the Congregational meeting, to be inserted into the master plan document.
4. Another change to be made in the Annual Report Booklet is on pg. 8, in the listing of Conference Delegates. Doug Berg's term has expired, so his name should be removed. And, Shirley Brandes' name should be added with a term of 2020-2024.
5. Plans were discussed for people to attend the Conference delegate session on line this coming Saturday, Nov. 6.
