Thank you so much for your thoughtful cards and gifts both for Christmas and my birthday! I hope all of you are managing to stay healthy and safe in this holiday season.

Although this is my second Christmas and birthday in Germany, this year I finally managed to get a taste of what the holiday season here is really like. All the Christmas markets were closed almost two weeks after opening (and most opened early this year), so once again, I haven't been able to experience a true German "Weihnachtsmarkt," but this year, our church was able to gather for Christmas Eve (although the number of guests allowed from outside of our congregation was limited), and I was able to celebrate Christmas with housemates and friends, instead of spending Christmas alone in quarantine. And this year, because only one of us (compared to six of us last year) in our house is currently in quarantine, I was able to host my first official "Kaffee und Kuchen" (Coffee and Cake), a German birthday tradition. It was a relatively small celebration, limited to just my housemates due to current regulations regarding private gatherings, but I am grateful for being able to enjoy even just a small "taste" of German culture in these extraordinary times.

Church Council Meeting
January 4, 2022**

1. Council considered and approved some more suggestions for the Lipscomb bequest money designated for the poor and needy of the community.
2. There was more discussion of the church heating system. Council agreed to purchase a new steam boiler furnace and to make repairs or upgrades to the current propane furnace. Also, a new dehumidifier will be purchased for the furnace room.
3. Council approved the purchase of a new computer and software for the church office.
4. The Bible School Committee will begin making plans for summer Bible School.
5. A request for support from the Student Aid fund was approved.
6. A committee was set in place for employee reviews.
