

SIGNIFICANT ITEMS CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING February 7, 2023

- 1. Jay Resh, representing the Cemetery Committee, attended the meeting to help in the discussion of possible guidelines for the Cemetery Committee. A committee will be formed to put some of these ideas on paper.
- 2. Level Acres has been contracted to fix the steps outside the furnace room door. They will also give an estimate to fix the outside steps that lead to the front of the sanctuary near the organ.
- 3. The church has received a donation of \$2000.00 in memory of Alvina Livengood, with the request that one half be designated for youth activities, and one half to be placed in the Cemetery Fund account.
- 4. Council discussed the secretary's salary and work schedule.
- 5. Council approved a request from the pickleball group to place permanent tape lines on the gym floor to outline boundaries for the game.
- 6. There was discussion of upcoming church activities, and approval for some expenditures for the Easter egg hunt.
- 7. There was discussion of suggestions for possible changes to the constitution and by-laws, or what else could be done, to make the Gifts Discernment job a bit easier.
