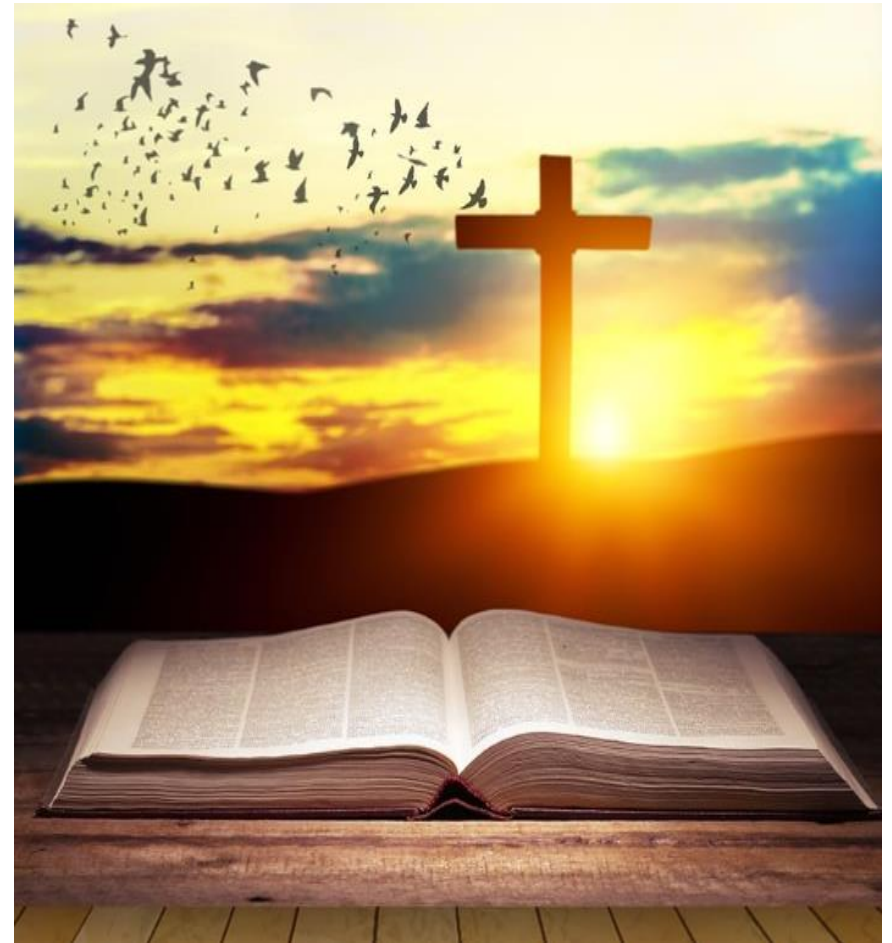

4. We read the Bible with a desire to obey its truth and life.
- 5 We see the Bible as what guides us to salvation in Christ and what equips us for teaching and right living.
6. We are willing to enter into ecumenical dialogue on the meaning of Scripture for Christian living.
