Any items you want to contribute can be placed in the back half of the World's Attic Closet (located at the bottom of the stairs between the gym and fellowship hall).

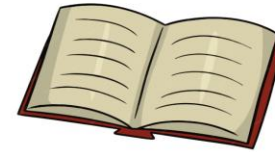
