

Chiasm in Luke 4

Notes:

1. The upper-case bold italics letters denote different sections of the chiasm. The uppercase bold italics letters with a single quote after the letter are referred to as a prime. For example, A' is A prime. Each section preceded with the same upper-case bold italics letter has a common theme (text in bold and underlined).
2. The yellow highlight is from Isaiah 61. The green highlight is from Isaiah 58.

A Jesus went to Nazareth, where he had been raised. On the Sabbath he went to the **synagogue** as he normally did and

B **stood up** to read.

C The synagogue assistant **gave him the scroll** from the prophet Isaiah.

D **He unrolled the scroll** and found the place where it was written:

E *The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
because the Lord has anointed me.
He has sent me **to preach** good news to the poor,*

F *to **proclaim release to the prisoners***

G ***and recovery of sight to the blind,***

F' *to **liberate the oppressed,***

E' *and **to proclaim** the year of the Lord's favor.^[a]*

D' **He rolled up the scroll,**

C' **gave it back** to the synagogue assistant,

B' and **sat down.**

A' Every eye in the **synagogue** was fixed on him
